# TBAWA Rule: 17.14 Suicide Running

Umpires should be aware of any attempt by Coaches or runners to force errors by suicide running or barging. Any advantage gained by this practice shall be nullified and the runner returned to the base before this occurred. Any outs made shall stand. The umpire should at least warn any player they suspect might have committed this offence. In the more severe of cases

committed this offence. In the more severe of cases where injury could have occurred, the umpire has the right to give the player out or if called on by a Coach, eject the Coach. A Coach or player must have received at least one warning before ejection.

- 2) Parent helpers, please be advised that you will need to wear closed in shoes, a sleeved shirt and a hat.
- 3) Training is every Wednesday at 4 pm. All players need to attend.
